A fir, 18 ins. diam brs. N 58° E, 31 lks. dist.

A pine 22 ins. diam. brs. S 22° E 46 lks, dist.

MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES FOUND: Found the rotted remains of the Corner Tree, which is now a 10 foot high Douglas fir snag. Scribe marks // S are visible on weathered NE face of snag. The scribes are nearly chest high. There are also old axe marks on the tree. The snag has been burnt.

## From the Corner Tree:

A burnt out root hole bears N 58° E, 20.5 feet, (31 lks).

The Corner Tree is 2 feet South of a East-West fence line. There is evidence of a old fence, (fence post nailed to down and rotted stump), South of the Corner Tree and a old fence staple on the East side of the Corner Tree. The existing North-South fence angles about 100 feet South of the Corner Tree and intersects the East-West fence line about 35 feet East of the corner.

## MONUMENT SET:

Drove a 5/8 by 24 inch rebar in the center of the root crown of the Corner Tree and capped with a 2 inch aluminum cap marked as shown in "Monument Marking Detail". Marked 4 new bearing trees:

A 6 inch ponderosa pine bears N 78° W, 45.3 feet scribed 1/4 S13 BT.

A 7 inch Douglas fir bears S 58° E, 23.7 feet scribed 1/4 S24 BT.

A 9 inch ponderosa pine bears S 17° W 34.3 feet scribed 1/4 S 24 BT.

A 8 inch ponderosa pine bears S 43° W 87.1 feet scribed 1/4 S 24 BT.

New bearing trees have a 3/4 inch brass washer stamped "PLS 1106" nailed to the face of blaze. Attached bearing object signs to the new bearing trees. Nailed a "Witness" sign to railroad tie brace post 2 feet South of the corner.

LOCATION AND COMMENTS: Corner falls on top of ridge about 15 feet East of a old road which has been fenced across.
