
Previous Renewals / Surveys, etc.

Corner originally set by George S. Pershin under contract #319 dated March 26, 1879. His record reads: Set granite stone $16 \times 10 \times 5$ on E. mountain side for cor. to secs. 22, 23, 26 and 27, from which:

A pine, 22 ins. diam. brs. N74°E, 88 lks. dist., A fir, 8 ins. diam. brs. S44°E, 71 lks. dist., A pine, 20 ins. diam. brs. S22°W, 86 lks. dist., A pine, 30 ins. diam. brs. N48°W, 14 lks. dist.,

Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source)

The original stone, plainly notched with 4 notches on one edge and 2 notches on another loose on the ground. A down, decayed pine with the pitched, scribed face, among the rotten wood in the location of the NW Bt. A sawed fir stump with the bottom of the BT blaze visible with no scribing left. A sawed pine stump with the scribed face detached and lying at the foot of the stump for the SW Bt.



MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description)
Set a 11/2" x 30" galvanized iron pipe with a 2 1/4" brass cap stamped as shown in the diagram above at record distances from the fir and SW BT stumps. Set a 6' steel post with a county monument sign attached along side. Buried the original stone at the foot of the pipe.

For references, I set four, 5/8" by 24" rebars with 1.25" red plastic caps stamped ORLS 852 and WALS 13922 as described below:

an iron rebar bears N63°28'04"W, 11.28 feet;

an iron rebar bears N13°23'54"E, 26.91 feet;

an iron rebar bears S14°28'48"W, 56.08 feet at the foot of the SW pine BT stump;

an iron rebar bears S45°38'31"E, 45.63 feet at the foot of the Fir BT stump;

The monument and references were tied using a LIECA system 300 RTK GPS.
