

Previous Renewals / Surveys, etc.

Corner originally set by George S. Pershin under contract #319 dated March 26, 1879. His record reads: Set granite stone, 16 x 8 x 6 on E. mountain side for 1/4 section cor. from which: A pine, 18 ins, diam., brs. N.28°W., 28 lks. dist.. A fir, 10 ins. diam., brs. S.72°E. 53 lks. dist..

Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source)

A granite stone 16 x 8 x 6, plainly chiseled 1/4 on the east face, firmly in place. A down pine about 20' northerly of the corner, badly decayed. A down, rotten fir,  $S72^{\circ}E$  at proper distance. The face was decayed but the overgrowth portion around the face showed some of the reverse scribing.



MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description)
Set a 1 1/2" x 30" galvanized iron pipe with a 2 1/4" brass cap stamped as shown in the diagram above at the position of the original stone. Set a 6' steel post with a county monument sign attached along side. Buried the original stone at the foot of the pipe.

For references, I set four 5/8" by 24" rebars with 1 1/8" red plastic caps stamped ORLS 852, and WALS 13922 as described below: an iron rebar bears N31°37'02"W, 65.98 feet; an iron rebar bears N30°16'53"E, 76.17 feet; an iron rebar bears S5°02'09"W, 62.69 feet; an iron rebar bears S26°16'00"E, 58.79 feet;

The monument and references were tied using a LIECA system 300 RTK GPS.
