3" brass cap on 2 1/2" I. pipe projecting 3" out of ground from which:

A 8" Spruce bears S37½°W 35.1 ft dist tagged N37½°E 53 lk dist (recent BT).

A 17" dia White Fir bears West 18.7 ft dist tagged East 28 lk dist (old BT healed blaze).

A 10" dia Lodge Pole Pine Snag bears East 5.2 ft dist tagged West 5.2 ft dist (old BT visible scribing).

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set steel fence post with 54-2 and 4 signs 5 ft North of corner.

Blaze faces and 6" band around bearing trees were painted red. Tagged trees with 54-3 and 4 signs where needed.

Used steel tape and magnetic compass 19 3/4° East declination. Measured to center of BTs.
