I assume the large burned snag to be the NE B.T. (over 50-inch diameter) because of its location in relation to the B.T. stump on which scribing is visible. The bearings to each from the rock mound approximately fits original GLO notes; however, the distances were called 80 links and 98 links respectively, but are actually approximately 180 links and 198 links. If the corner is assumed to be at the called distances, then the bearings would not fit as they now do.
