A 8" dia Pine bears N28°E 27 lks dist. A 6" dia Pine bears S20°E 41 lk dist. A 5" dia Pine bears S56°W 36 lk dist. A 6" dia Pine bears N2°W 40 lk dist.

Corner was remonumented in 1978 by BLM.

Description of corner evidence found:

3" brass cap on 2 1/2" I. pipe protruding 3" from ground in mound of stone from which:

A Pine Stump bears N28°E 20.4 ft dist - (old BT, sawn tree alongside with visible scribing).

A 12" dia Pine Stump bears N2°W 26.5 ft dist tagged S2°E 26.51 ft dist-(old BT, visible scribing).

A 20" dia Pine bears S59°W 24.0 ft dist tagged N59°E 24.0 ft dist - (old BT, healed blaze). A 15" dia Red Fir bears N66°W 49.1 ft dist tagged S66°E 74 lk dist - recent blaze.

A 17" dia Red Fir bears N642°E 92.0 ft dist tagged S642°W 140 lk dist - recent blaze.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Blaze faces and 6" bands around bearing trees are painted red. Tagged trees with 54–3 & 4 signs where needed. Set steel fence post with 54–4 sign attached, North of corner.

Used steel tape and magnetic compass 19 3/4° East declination. Measured to center of BTs.

Corner maintained on October 7, 1982.
