Description of corner evidence found:

None found. A fir 12" in dia. bears  ${\rm N40}^{\rm O}{\rm E}$ , 10.6 feet partially opened with letter B visible. Old rotten stump about 7' south lying on the ground. No scribing could be found.

At point S400W, 10.6 feet set  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" galvanized pipe with brass cap marked:

Set pipe 24" in the ground, with mound of stone around.
