Set a basalt stone, 20" x 10" x 7", on a S.W. slope in a mound of stones, marked 1/4 on west face. No trees near, raise a mound of stones alongside in lieu of pits.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the 6/30/95 original location of this corner:

Moving the corner stone aside, I set in it's place a 1 1/2" x 30" iron pipe 24" into the ground, with a 2 1/2" brass cap attached which is marked as shown in the diagram above. I bury the original stone up-side-down along the south side of the pipe and build up the original stone mound. From which:

A 5/8" x 36" iron rod set 35" into the ground with a 1 1/2" aluminum cap attached bears $N23^{\circ}$ 30'E, 17.3 feet. This reference monument is in a fence corner with fences projecting north and west. Cap is marked:

A 5/8" x 36" iron rod set 35" into the ground with a 1 1/2" aluminum cap attached bears $S68^{\circ}$ 30'E, 57.1 feet. Cap is marked:

A $5/8" \times 24"$ iron rod set 21" into the ground with a 1 1/2" aluminum cap attached bears S37°W, 36.6 feet. Cap is marked:
