Set a 2" I.D. galvanized iron pipe 30" long with 2 1/2" brass cap stamped as shown in the diagram above. Set pipe 26" into the ground.

Placed a 3' diameter collar of stone around the monument and set a steel fence post 5' west of the monument with Forest Service Land Survey Monument and Property Boundary signs attached. The bearings are true. Scribed W1/16 S11 BT on a 15" White Fir which bears N64° 57'W, 36.6'. Scribed W1/16 S14 BT on a 8" White Fir which bears S54°04'W, 19.1'. The bearings are true. Each scribe is in a 24" blaze. Nailed an aluminum washer stamped RLS 852 between the letters B and T on each tree. Painted a 6" red band around the new bearing trees and attached Forest Service Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.
