CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

The original corner was established by George Pershin under G.L.O. contract 430, dated March 23, 1882. His record reads:

Set a basalt Stone 20x12x4 in on rocky point in mound of Stone for 1/4 Sec. Cor. marked 1/4 on W. face no trees raised a mound of stone alongside

Description of corner evidence found:

Found small stone mound with 20x12x4 stone with 1/4 chiseled in face. Mound was on old north south fence line just south of jog in newer fence.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the recovered position of the original stone, I set a 2" I.D. galvanized iron pipe 30" long with 2 1/2" brass cap stamped as shown in the diagram above. Set pipe 18" into the ground. Buried original stone alongside.

Placed a 3' diameter mound of stone around the monument and set a steel fence post 5' north of the monument with Forest Service Land Survey Monument sign attached. Scribed 1/4 S15 BT on a 15" Ponderosa Pine which bears N85°30'W, 15.0'. Scribed 1/4 S14 BT on a 10" Ponderosa Pine which bears S1°00'E, 48.7'. The bearings are magnetic with a declination of 20° East. Each scribe is in a 24" blaze. Nailed an aluminum washer, stamped RLS 852, between the letters B and T on each tree. Painted a 6" red band around the new bearing trees and attached Forest Service Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.

I certify the above corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on October 28, 1987.
