## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment: Corner was originally established by George S. Pershin, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, under Contract No. 430, dated May 1882. The original notes state that at the corner a 14" x 8"x 5" basalt stone was set 10" in ground marked with 3 notches on 5 and 4 notches on E edges from which:

N-9 DIAGRAM T3S R32E \$17 | \$16 S20 S21

A 10" dia Fir bears N17°E 33 lk dist. A 14" dia Tamarack bears S62°E 48 lk dist.

No restoration appears in County Records.

Description of corner evidence found:

A 32" dia Fir Stump bears N15°E 21.78 ft dist - (old BT healed blaze) A 18" dia Tamarack Stump bears S60°E 31.68 ft dist - (old BT visible scribing).

Found 17" x 11" x 4" basalt stone lying on surface of ground in vicinity of corner.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set 2 1/2" brass cap on 2 1/2" x 30" I. pipe 24" in ground with mound of earth from which:

A 11" dia White Fir bears S83°E 45.8 ft dist marked: T3S R32E S21 BT.

A 8" dia Red Fir bears N24°E 46.3 ft dist marked: T3S R32E S16 BT.

A 12" dia White Fir bears N65°W 62.3 ft dist marked: T3S R32E S17 BT.

A 9" dia Red Fir bears S46 1/2°W II.2 ft dist marked: T3S R32E S20 BT.

A steel fence post with 54-2 and 4 signs West of corner.

Blaze faces and 6" band around bearing trees painted red. Trees tagged with 54-3 and 4 signs. Each new BT has lower blaze, scribed BT with brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed flush. Used steel tape and magnetic compass 19 3/4° East declination. Measured to center of BTs.

Corner monumented on September 27, 1982.
