At the comer location, found 3" brass cap on 2 1/2" I. pipe in mound of stone, from which:

A 29" P. Pine bears N48°W 43.3 ft. dist. tagged S48°E 64 lk w/partially open blaze (original BT) A 23" P. Pine bears S43°E 27.8 ft. dist. tagged N43°W-27.8 ft w/chopped out blaze (original BT)

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set steel fence posts 3 ft. West and South and attached signs 54-2 facing North and East respectively and 54-4 sign on the West post.

Painted red the face of blazes and 6" bands around bearing trees. Tagged trees w/54-3 & 4 signs where needed.

Used steel tape and magnetic compass 19 3/4° East declination. Measured to center of BTS.

This comer maintained on September 22, 1982.

## History of 1977 BLM Remonumentation

The 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 26 and 27, monumented with the original basalt stone,  $12 \times 8 \times 7$  ins., firmly set 8 ins. in the ground, mkd. 1/4 on N. face, from which the original bearing trees:
