No record of restoration was found in County Records.

Description of corner evidence found:

A 12" x 12" x 6" basalt stone on slope with 1/4 marked on the W face, from which:

A 29" P. Pine bears S67°W - 76.5 ft. dist. (original BT with healed blaze).

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a 2 1/2" x 30" I. pipe w/3" brass cap 21" in the ground with mound of stones and corner stone buried alongside. The monument is leaning slightly East due to a root, from which:

A 20" Red Fir bears S45°E 3.8 ft. dist. marked: 1/4 S25 BT

Blaze faces and 6" band around bearing trees are painted red. Trees tagged with 54-3 & 4 signs where needed.

New BT has lower blaze, scribed BT, with brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed flush.

Used steel tape and magnetic compass 19 3/4° East declination.

Measured to center of BTs.
