A 12" dia Fir Stump bears N76°E 52.14 ft dist tagged S76°W 52.1 ft dist (oldBT scribing visible)

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set 2 1/2" brass cap on 2 1/2" x 30" 1. pipe 22" in ground with mound of stone from which:

A 10" Grand Fir bears S50°E 6.8 ft dist marked: T3S R32E S32 CC BT. A 10" Grand Fir bears N15 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E 37.5 ft dist marked: T3S R32E S29 CC BT.

Blaze faces and 6" band around bearing trees painted red. Tagged trees with 54-3 and 4 signs. Each new BT has lower blaze, scribed BT, with brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed flush.

A steel fence post with 54-4 sign, 3.7 ft East of corner.

Used steel tape and magnetic compass 19 3/4° East declination. Measured to center of trees.
