
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

I set a 3/4" ins. diam. by 30 ins. long alum. drive rod, buried 36 ins. in the ground, with magnet in 9 ins. long break-away base, with a 3½ ins. diam. alum. cap, 6 ins. below the surface, mkd. as shown:

A pink DEEP-1 magnet, buried 12 ins. below the surface, bears S. 51½° E., 9.4 ft. dist. A blue DEEP-1 magnet, buried 12 ins. below the surface, bears S. 53° W., 8.5 ft. dist.
