
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION



Original corner set by Timothy W. Davenport, under GLO Contract No. 101, approved December 7, 1861.

Record states:

Set qr. sec. post in mound with charred stake as per instructions.

Subsequent Monumentation

Corner reestablished by Verl R. Fraley, LS 183, as described by County Survey No. Q-937-Ax, dated 1949, in the records of the Umatilla County Surveyor. Record states:

Found 12"x12"x18" boulder 1 ft. under road surface. Found no markings on it. Set temp. point for E.14 cor.

Set 1" I.Pin 8" under road surface just east and alongside 12"x12"x18" boulder for the E.1/4 corner of Sec. 32.

References: Nail in P. Pole bears N. 60° W., dist. 32.1 ft. Nail in P. Pole bears S. 45° E., dist. 34.4 ft.

Corner refurbished by Verl R. Fraley, LS 183, as described by County Survey No. Q-695-Ax, dated June 1, 1950, in the records of the Umatilla County Surveyor. Record states:

Found a 5/8" I. Pin (East 1/4 Corner) which I established in 1949.

Corner remonumented by David H. Krumbein, LS 933, as described by County Survey No. I-26-B, dated June 21, 1974, in the records of the Umatilla County Surveyor. Record states:

Found 1" Pin. Brass cap set.

Corner perpetuated by G. Dennis Edwards, LS 951, as described by County Survey No. 95-60-B, dated 3/95, in the records of the Umatilla County Surveyor.

Record states:

Original surveyor Davenport, 1861, #101. He set a post in mound with charred stake. Fraley 1949 set 5/8" I. Pin. Krumbein 1974 set B.C. in place of 5/8" I. Pin.

Found 21/2" B.C., 5" below surface.

Found 21/2" B.C. W.C., S61°02'40"E, 38.03 ft. (stamped 38.00')

New accessories:

1/2"x24" rebar with #951, bears N42°33'30"W, 43.25 ft. dist. 5/8"x30" rebar, p. cap #951, bears S63°22'30"W, 67.33 ft. dist. Alum. tag #951 in P. Pole, bears N57°31'30"E, 65.20 ft. dist. 2½" B.C. 1974 38.00, bears S61°02'40"E, 38.03 ft. dist.

Corner perpetuated by Brit L. Primm, LS 48509, as described by County Survey No. 02-49-G, dated 2/02, in the records of the Umatilla County Surveyor. Record states:

Originally surveyed in 1861 by Davenport under Contract #101. He set a post in a mound of earth and a charred stake. In 1949 Fraley set a 5/8" iron rod. In 1974 Krumbein set a B.C. in place of 5/8" iron rod.

Monuments and accessories found:

A 1/2" x 24" iron rod with a yellow plastic cap mkd. #951 lies N42°38'08"W, 43.20 feet. An aluminum tag #951 on a poer [sic] pole lies N57°31'08"E, 65.19 feet. A 2½" brass cap 1974 lies S61°02'52"E, 38.08 feet.

New Accessories from which:

A 5/8" x 30" iron rod with a yellow plastic cap mkd. PLS LS 48509 lies S75°52'05"W, 61.27 feet.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found a 21/2 ins. diam. brass cap, firmly set, 5 ins. below the asphalt, in the intersection of S. Edwards Road and Harding Ave., mkd. as shown:

From the recovered monument I find the Krumbein accessory:

A 1½ ins. diam. steel pipe with cap cut off, 2 ins. above ground, bears S. 61° E., 38.0 ft. dist., with guard post 1 ft. S'ly of monument.

and accessories mkd. by Edwards:

An alum, tag #951 on P. Pole, bears N. 57½° E., 65.2 ft. dist.
A 1/2 ins. diam. iron rod with 1 ins. yellow plastic cap mkd. Edwards LS 951, flush with ground, bears N. 421/2° W., 43.3 ft. dist.

and accessory mkd. by Primm:

A 5/8 ins. diam. iron rod, no cap, down 2 ins. below gravel, bears S. 76° W., 61.3 ft. dist.






