

MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description)

At a point just southwest of the fence intersection, I set a 1.25" x 30" galvanized iron pipe with a 2.25" brass cap stamped as shown in the diagram above, flush with ground surface.

## REFERENCES SET:

I set 4 - 5/8" x 24" iron rebars with 1.25" plastice caps stamped ORLS 852 and WALS 13922 as described below:

An iron rebar bears N85°58'W, 33.97 feet with the plastic cap flush with the ground surface. An iron rebar bears S83°39'W, 8.61 feet with the plastic cap flush with the ground surface. An iron rebar bears S6°47'W, 6.94 feet with the plastic cap flush with the ground surface. An iron rebar bears S6°23'W, 35.26 feet with the plastic cap flush with the ground surface.
