A 5/8" x 30" rebar set 28" into the ground, with a red plastic cap stamped PLS 54871, bears N190E, 66.5 feet.

A  $5/8" \times 30"$  rebar set 28" into the ground, with a red plastic cap stamped PLS 54871, bears  $S81^{\circ}E$ , 22.1 feet.

A 5/8" x 30" reber set 28" into the ground, with a red plastic cap stamped PLS 54871, bears S320W, 43.0 feet.

A 5/8" x 30" rebar set 28" into the ground, with a red plastic cap stamped PLS 54871, bears N780W, 29.6 feet.
