Cor., dug pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins., N. & S. of stake, 5 1/2 ft. dist., raised mound of earth, 1 1/2 ft. high, 3 1/2 ft. base over it, and in N. pit; drove stake 2 ft. long, 2 ins. sq., 12 ins. in the ground, marked 1/4 S. on W. face. Wagon spindle was found for the corner by Willard Bradley, County Surveyor, in April 1915, during Bradley's County Survey No. 406.
