

Previous Renewals / Surveys, etc.

Corner originally set by William H. Odell under contract No. 114 dated July 2, 1866. His record reads: Set basalt stone 9 x 11 x 12 for 1/4 sec. cor. on steep hillside facing the N.

Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source)

I found an unmarked basalt stone 9" x 8" x 4" at the foot of a 40" diameter Ponderosa Pine stump. The stump was the corner post for a 3 way fence intersection with fences running east, west and south. The stump had a blazed face on the south side that was plainly marked 1/4 S. The stump had wire well grown into it on both the north and south sides.



MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description)

I Set a 1 1/4" x 30" Galvanized Iron Pipe with a 2 1/2" brass cap stamped a shown in the diagram above at the point of the stone which was also the oldest fence intersection.

For references, I set four 5/8" by 24" rebars with 1.25" orange plastic caps stamped WTS and 56295LS as described below:

an iron rebar bears N82°18'04"W, 83.82 feet;

an iron rebar bears N38°54'12"W, 32.67 feet;

an iron rebar bears N36°27'05"E, 22.69 feet;

an iron rebar bears S13°11'40"E, 19.77 feet;

This monument and references were tied useing a Trimble R7/R8 RTK GPS.
