MONUMENT SET: At a point just North of the old locust post fence corner, set a 2 1/2 brass cap on 1 1/4 by 30" galvanized iron pipe 25" in the ground. Cap is marked as shown in "Monument Marking Detail".

New accessories:

A 4" Ponderosa Pine bears N 04° E, 54.5' scribed X at breast height and BT at base of tree.

A 8" Ponderosa Pine bears S 53° E, 12.3' scribed 1/4 S28 BT.

A 6" Ponderosa Pine bears S 26° W, 72.7' scribed 1/4 S28 BT.

A 5/8 by 24" rebar with 1 1/4" red plastic cap bears N 85° W, 18.1', set at South base of round wood post in fence line extending West.

Attached bearing tree signs to the new bearing trees and wired sign to rebar accessory. Red plastic cap is marked "OR PLS 1106 WA PLS 17372".

Nailed a "witness" sign to locust post by the corner monument.

LOCATION AND COMMENTS: Corner is located at fence corner West of a dirt road which turns East near the corner monument. Used Spencer tape and compass with 14° East declination to measure corner accessories.
