History of original corner establishment:

This corner was originally established by William Odell, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, under Contract No. 114, dated July 2, 1866. The original notes state:

Map No. 84-39-B indicates a brass cap monument set at a fence intersection. I find no definable fence intersection and no evidence of the brass cap monument as of July, 1992.

Description of corner evidence found:

No evidence of the original corner stone was found after a diligent search of radius of 150' around the calculated corner point. The corner area is on a steep hillside covered with rock. Fences have been constructed through the corner area and many stones used as fence jacks.

The corner point was re-established by single proportion measurement between the Northeast and Northwest corners of Section 25. The re-established corner position lines up with fences approaching from the North and South.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a 2 1/2" brass cap on a 1 1/4" by 30" galv. iron pipe 22" in ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone. Cap marked as shown.

No trees are near corner, marked 4 rock outcrops for bearing objects:
