History of original corner establishment:

This corner was originally established by William Odell, U. S. Deputy Surveyor, under Contract No. 114 dated July 2, 1866. The original notes state that at the corner a post was set for the corner from which:

A 24" pine bears N11" M 67 1ks. A 20" pine bears 523 W 130 1ks.

In 1889, during his County Survey No. 46, surveyor Arnold found the original wood post and resonweented it with a baselt stone. Arnold also marked a new bearing tree: A 12 dine bears 849°30'W 11' scribed 1/4 S BT CS.

## Description of corner evidence found:

Found a 13" by 11" by 3" basalt stone, lying flat, marked "1/4" on top. The stone found is located  $955^\circ E$  3', from a fence corner with fences going east, northwest and south.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the position of the found stone, set a 2 1/2" brass cap on a 1 1/2" by 30" galv. iron pipe, 28" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth. Placed stone in the new mound. From the new monument:

A 24" ponderosa pine bears 839°E 24.2' scribed 1/4 830 BT. A 18" ponderosa pine bears N55°E 15.0' scribed 1/4 S19 BT.

Bearing trees have bearing object signs attached to them.

Set steel fence post north of corner and attached witness corner sign.
