Description of corner evidence found:

None, other than a north-south fence. The corner area has been farmed over for years.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Reestablished corner position using the existing north-south fence for departure and a straight line between the found north one-quarter corner of Section 33 and the found northeast corner of Section 34 for latitude. Set a 2 1/2" brass cap on a 1 1/2" by 30" galv. iron pipe 28" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth. Since there are no trees near, I set two reference monuments as follows:
A 1 1/2" plastic cap marked "W.R. Wells, PLS 1106", set on a 5/8" by 30" iron rod bears N1°E 33.4'. Set steel fence post with bearing object sign near the reference monument.
A 1 1/2" alum. cap on a 5/8" by 30" iron rod bears S1°W 26.0', marked as shown below. Set steel fence post near the reference monument with bearing object sign attached.

Set steel fence post north of corner and attached witness corner sign.
