Description of corner evidence found:

Found round 1" diameter by 30 inch long rod protruding 3" from the ground. This monument has been used by surveyors Krumbein and Wells and shows on old state highway maps for the Weston-Tollgate highway. The origin of the iron rod is unknown.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the position of the iron rod monument , set a 2 1/2" brass cap on a 1 1/2" by 30" iron pipe 24" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone. Placed the iron rod monument inside the new monument. Referenced the new monument as follows:

A 21" white fir bears 95° E 14.5' scribed T4N R36E 836 BT. A 4" ponderosa pine bears N28°E 53.3' scribed "X" at breast height and "BT" at base. No other trees are convienent for reference. Attached bearing object sign to each of the bearing trees.

Also set a concrete nail in the south side of pole no. 267001. The nail bears N80°W 52.3' from the new monument and is about 1' above the ground. Placed bearing object sign on the pole.

Set steel fence post west of the corner monument with witness corner sign attached.
