History of original corner establishment:

This corner was originally established by William Odell, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, under Contract No. 114, dated July 2, 1866. The original notes state that at the corner a wood post was set from Which:

A 6" pine bears N50°E 26 lks. A 8" pine bears 570°W 18 lks.

In 1897, during his County Survey No. 46, Surveyor Arnold reestablished the corner after finding the original corner gone and the original bearing trees 42 feet apart, as follows:

"I find, from original notes, the point best to harmonize courses and distances and set a basalt stone 20 by 16 by 4 ins, on hill side facing N, stone marked 1/4 on N., from which one original B.T, bears SS9'W 17' dist and the other B.T. bears MS2'30'E 26' dist from stone.

Found 18" by 15" by 6" basalt stone as established by Arnold, firmly set, marked "1/4" on north face, from which:

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner:

At the position of the found stone, set a 2 1/2" brass cap on a 1 1/2" by 30" galv. iron pipe, 24" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth. Buried marked stone in the earth mound. From the new corner monument:

A 10" ponderosa pine bears \$88°W 18.4' scribed 1/4 \$31 BT. A 22" ponderosa pine bears \$840°E 32.0' scribed 1/4 \$30 BT.

Bearing trees have bearing object signs attached to them.

Set steel fence post east of corner and attached witness corner sign.

Corner is located 5' SW of a fence running N48°W from the corner area.
