History of original corner establishment:

This corner was originally established by Odell and Lewis, U.S. Deputy Surveyors, under Contract No. 110 dated February 7, 1865. The original nature state that at the corner a wood post and barked stone was set in a sound of stone. Corner Code No. Z-3 Note: Monument marked as shown below

Description of corner evidence found:

None. The corner area falls on a very steep, rocky hillside.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Corner position was reestablished by single proportion measure between the Southwest and Southeast corners of Section 31, (there is a fence running between the Southwest and Southeast corners of Section 31). The corner falls on a steep, rocky, unstable hillside, 8' north of a fence. Set a 5/8" by 30" iron rod with 1 1/2" aluminum cap, marked as shown in corner diagram, 24" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of stone from which:

A 2' by 2' by 3' out of ground rock in place bears $989^{\circ}E$ 6.9' marked "X BO" on West face. A 2' by 4' by 5' out of ground rock in place bears $931^{\circ}W$ 6.8' marked "X BO" on Northeast face.

Set steel fence post West of corner and attached witness corner sign.
