## Description of corner evidence found:

Uprooted Section 6 bearing tree, now a 15" ponderosa pine snag, 15' long, with full scribes on upper and lower blazes. There is also and uprooted, rotted, ponderosa pine in approximately the correct position to be the Section 32 bearing tree.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At a point N35°E 7.9' from the root hole of the Section 6 bearing tree, set a 2 1/2" brass cap on a 1 1/2" by 30" galv. iron pipe 24" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth from which:

A 17" douglas fir bears N39°E 11.9' scribed T4N R36E S32 BT. A 16" douglas fir bears N11°W 19.0' scribed T4N R36E S31 BT.

No trees are convienent for reference to the south.

Placed bearing object sign on each of the bearing trees and set a steel fence post west of the corner and attached witness corner sign.

This corner falls in an east-west fence on a steep, brushy, north slope.
