Description of corner evidence found:

Found a basalt stone 15 x 10 x 6 ins. marked 1/4 on one side, also a mound of stone from which a pine, now 36° in diameter, bears 3.38° E. at 310 links distant. The pine has a Boise Cascade Co. location poster attached. The old blaze has been opened up (not by me) enough to show the old scar and scribe marks.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

diameter pipe 36" long, with the bottom flared and a 3" bronze disk brazed to the top, 24" in the ground; set the stone marked 1/4 on the side in the hole and backfilled with earth and stones.

The disk is stamped thus $\frac{1/4}{9.6}$ Ore, 422 1971

From the pipe monument a red fir 28" in diameter bears 3.40° W. at 74 feet distant. I placed a Forest Service location poster and a 7"x 10" yellow Attention poster on the tree.

I blazed the tree and marked it 1/4 S 7 B T
