A 24" dead standing ponderosa pine snag 10' high brs s23  $3/4^{\circ}W$ , 143.1' with scribes visible on opened

A 16" dead standing ponderosa pine brs N66 3/4°W, 77.0' with scribes visible on opened blaze. (OBT)

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position of found stone ...

Set  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap on  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe 18" in ground to bedrock & surrounded with mound of earth & stone. Set 6' fence post North of corner with sign 54-4 attached. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram. Buried corner stone in new mound.

New bearing trees established:

A 16" ponderosa pine brs N32°E, 55.8' scribed T4NR38ES5 BT. A 22" ponderosa pine brs S17°E, 46.5' scribed T4NR38ES8 BT. A 19" ponderosa pine brs S59 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W, 92.8' scribed T4NR38ES7 BT. A 15" ponderosa pine brs N44 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W, 26.8' scribed T4NR38ES6 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3 & 54-4 to each BT and painted face of blaze & 6" red band around each BT.
