
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

## History of original corner establishment:

Corner was estalbished as part of this survey, on the East line of Sec.12, T 4 N R 37 E, midway latitudinally between the N.W. and S.W. corners of Sec.7.



Description of corner evidence found:

None.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position determined by survey...

Set  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap on  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe 15" in ground to bedrock & surrounded with mound of earth & stone. Set 6' fence post South of corner with sign 54-9 attached. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram.

New bearing trees established: A 20" ponderosa pine brs  $S18\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}E$ , 23.6' scribed 1/4S7 BT. A 16" ponderosa pine brs  $N54\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}E$ , 55.8' scribed 1/4S7 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3 & 54-9 to each BT and painted face of blaze & 6" red band around each BT. Compass declination  $19^{\circ}$  East.
