
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position determined by survey... Set $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap on $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe 24" in ground to bedrock & surrounded with mound of earth & stone. Set 6' fence post North of corner with signs 54-9 & 54-2 attached. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram.

New bearing trees established; A 14" ponderosa pine brs N53 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W, 63.1' scribed C-S1/16S7 BT. A 28" ponderosa pine brs N14°W, 31.9' scribed C-S1/16S7 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3~&~54-9 to each BT and painted face of blaze &~6" red band around each BT.

Compass declination 160 East.
