Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

I set a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe 26" in the ground. I stamped the cap as shown in the diagram above. A 30" mound of stone is placed around the monument.

I set the following new witness trees:

A 9" dbh Douglas Fir bears N70°24'W, 21.6', scribed C 1/4 S30 BT. A 6" dbh White Fir bears N79°35'E, 41.7', scribed C 1/4 S30 BT. A 14" dbh White Fir bears S51°33'E, 85.0', scribed C 1/4 S30 BT. A 8" dbh Alpine Fir bears S13°18'E, 20.0', scribed C 1/4 S30 BT. The bearings are based on traverse control stations and are true. A brass washer stamped ORLS852 and WALS 13922 is attached between the letters B and T with a brass screw on each new tree. All the BT's have Bearing Tree and Land Survey Monument signs attached. A red stripe is painted around each tree at chest height.
