Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: I set a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe 26" in the ground. I stamped the cap as shown in the diagram above. A 24" collar of stone is placed around the monument.

I set the following new witness trees:

A 24" dbh Engleman Spruce bears N47°23'W, 70.2', scribed SW 1/16 S30 BT. A 14" dbh White Fir bears N16°12'E, 55.1', scribed SW 1/16 S30 BT. The bearings are based on the traverse control stations and are true. A brass washer stamped ORLS852 and WALS 13922 is attached between the letters B and T with a brass screw on each new tree. All the BT's have Bearing Tree and Land Survey Monument signs attached. A red stripe is painted around each tree at chest height.
