His record reads: Seta a basalt stone 16x12x5 ins 11 ins in ground for 1/4 sec cor marked 1/4 on N face from which a fir 1 24 ins dia bears S16°W 230 lks dist marked 1/4 S BT. 1 A fir 20 ins dia bears N42°W 300 lks dist marked 1/4 S1 1 S30 - ---4 S31 The corner was remonumented in 1939 by Gould under 1939 special instructions. His record reads: At point for cor. Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. 1 diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with the original stone 1 deposited at the base, for 1/4 sec. cor., with brass 1 cap marked(see diagram) from which a rotten and fallen fir, bears N.42°W., 300 lks. dist., marks rotted off. (Old B. T.)
A rotten and fallen fir, bears S.16°W., 230 lks. dist., marks rotted off. (Old B. T.) A double Tamarack, 9 ins. diam., bears N.50°W., 285 lks. dist., marked 1/4 S 30 B T. (New B. T.) A spruce, 16 ins. diam., bears S.22°E., 191 lks. dist., marked 1/4 S 31 B T. (New B. T.) Description of corner evidence found: Found 2 1/2" GLO brass cap in good condition in a mound of stone. Found 16" dbh double Western Larch stump with healed blaze N50°W, 188.1'. No evidence of other BT's found. Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner: I set the following new witness trees: A 14" dbh Western Larch bears S14°46'E, 142.9', scribed 1/4 S31 BT. A 7" dbh White Fir bears S16°57'W, 96.1', scribed 1/4 S31 BT. A 5/8" rebar with 2" Al cap bears N45°37'E, 103.1', stamped BO Cor S45°37'W 103.1'. A short power pole with plate UECA 4N E 31490 bears N56°47'W, 4.6' scribed 1/4 S30 BO. The bearings are based on traverse control stations and are true. A brass washer stamped ORLS852 and WALS 13922 is attached between the letters B and T with a brass screw on each new tree. All the BT's have Bearing Tree and Land Survey Monument signs attached.
