CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION


History of original corner establishment:

Corner established by Ronald L. Munns 11-1-83, documented by survey filed with Umatilla County Surveyor. Survey was done for York and Key. Survey Record states:

Set a 14' pipe From which:

A 10" Spruce bears N 8 E, 5.84 feet to a nail in a blate.

A 15" Spruce bears N 73 W, 22.46 feet to a nail in a blaze.



No record of subsequent remonumentation was found in County Records. Description of corner evidence found:

Found a 14 galvanized pipe.

Found:

A 10" Spruce N 12 E, (record N 8 E) 5.84 feet, distances to double headed form nail set in blaze.

An 18" spruce bears N 73 W, 22.46 feet, distances taken to a doubleheaded form nail set in blaze.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

I placed a $2^{1}2^{1}\times30^{11}$ aluminum pipe with aluminum cap, marked as shown over the $1^{1}4^{1}$ pipe, buried the new monument 26^{11} in the ground.

From which:

A 12" Spruce bears S 82 E, 48.5 feet, marked X Bt, on a single blaze. A 23" Spruce bears S 31 E, 37.9 feet, marked CW 1/16 S 32 BT, on a single blaze.

I set steel fence posts 5 feet East with 54-2 and 54-9 signs attached. I also set a steel fence post 5 feet south with a 54-2 sign.
