

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: At surveyed position, I set a $2^{\frac{1}{2}}$ inch x 30 inch aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, $2^{\frac{1}{4}}$ inches in the ground and raised a mound of stone around monument. Corner falls on the toe of the fill on the South side of Highway 204. From which:

New BTs

A 22 inch diameter Spruce bears N310E 94.3 feet marked CE 1/16 S32 BT on a single blaze A 6 inch diameter Spruce bears N870E, 24.0 feet marked X BT on a single blaze


Set a steel fencepost approximately 5 feet East with 54-2 and 54-9 signs attached

Set a 4"x4" wood post with wooden forest boundary sign approximately 8 feet North

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of these accessories. I used 20° East magnetic declination and the distances are to the center of the trees. I set a grass washer marked OPLS 991 by the BT blaze. I painted a 6 inch red band around BTs and attached 54-3 and 54-9 signs
