Description of corner evidence found:

None.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

After a thorough search of the area this corner was re-established by single proportion measure between the S 1/4 and S W corner of Section 34, T3S, R31E based on record distances from retracement survey by Pershin in September 1880, at which point I set:

A 2 1/2" brass cap on 2 1/2" x 30" I. pipe 16" in the groundwith mound of stone from which:

A 13" dia Red Fir bears S79°E 48.4 ft dist marked: 1/4 S2 BT. A 10" dia Red Fir bears S27°W 9.5 ft dist marked: 1/4 S2 BT.

Blaze faces and 6" bands around bearing trees are painted red. Tagged trees with 54-3 & 4 signs. New BTs have a lower blaze, scribed BT, with a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed flush. Set steel fence post with 54-2 & 4 signs West of corner.

Used steel tape and magnetic compass 19 3/4° East declination. Measured to center of BTs.

Corner monumented on October 21, 1982.
