

Previous Renewals / Surveys, etc.

Corner originally set by George S. Pershin under contract No. 373 dated September 17, 1880. His record reads: Set basalt stone 26 x 14 x 10 on N.E. slope in mound of stone for 1/4 sec. cor.

Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source)

The original stone, lightly but plainly marked 1/4, firmly in place at the south edge of a mound of stone about 8 feet in diamter. The majority of the stone mound appeared to be an old rock jack and had some old fence wire protruding from it.



MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description)

At the corner point I set a 2 3/8" brass cap on a 1 1/2" x 30" galvanized iron pipe 26" in the ground to bedrock. I buried the original stone along the pipe on the north side and made a small collar of stone around the cap. I stamped the cap as shown in the diagram above.

For references, I set four 5/8" by 24" rebars with 1.25" orange plastic caps stamped WTS and 56295LS as described below:

an iron rebar bears N45°48'09"W, 147.40 feet;

an iron rebar bears N17°51'21"E, 124.77 feet;

an iron rebar bears S52°47'49"E, 49.41 feet;

an iron rebar bears S6°30'40"W, 54.65 feet;

The monument and references were tied using a Trimble R7/R8 RTK GPS.
