
## **CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION / RESTORATION**

History of original corner establishment:

This corner was originally established by Timothy Davenport under G.L.O. contract No. 101, dated August 5, 1861. Survey General notes state:

Set post corner to Secs 25, 26, 35 & 36, made mound and drove charred stake as per inst.



Description of corner evidence found:

No evidence of this corner is found. Set monument at double proportionate measure.

Description of monument and accessories I establish to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At proportionate position determined by survey, Set a  $2-1/2" \times 30"$  aluminum pipe monument with 3" dia. cap stamped as shown in the DIAGRAM, 8" blow the gravel road surface, from which:

A 5/8" rebar pin bears N42°38'26"W, 36.95 ft.

A 5/8" rebar pin with 1 groove filed on the top, bears N35°04′54″E, 30.51 ft. The north face of an 8" dia. irrigation stand pipe bears  $$34^{\circ}47'25"E$, 53.80 ft.$ Twisted spike in a utility pole bears S88°24'23"W, 73.59 ft.

Placed an orange plastic cap marked "FS&E Survey Marker" on all rebar pins.
