Record states: Set and marked brass disc, marked as shown in "Monument Marking. Detail". Maintained by Frank A. Tuers, Dependent Resurvey, under Special Instructions dated April 11, 1975. Record states: Found corner monumented with an iron post, 2 1/2 ins.diam., firmly set, protruding 12 ins. above ground, and in a mound of stone, 2.1/2 ft. base, 6 ins. high, with brass cap marked as shown in "Monument Marking Detail". Add the marks BLM 1975 to brass cap. Corner re-established by G. Dennis Edwards, Umatilla County Survey Records #91-01-B, dated January 1991. Record states: Found a 2 1/2" brass cap on an iron pipe. This cap was set in 1972 by Don Staebler. It lies N 89053'41" W 12.48 feet from my single proportion location for this corner. The date stamped on cap was 1971. The BLM added 1975 to this cap. Set by single proportion a 1" x 30" iron pipe with a brass cap, stamped T5N, S13 | S18

\$24 | \$19, 1990, LS 951, 0.4 feet above surface of ground and raised a soil mound around the brass cap. See my 1989 area one county survey. A steel guard post with bearing object and witness sign attached referencing B.M. Elev. 496.821 N 05022'20" W 385.28 feet. A R/R tie with an Alum. tag #951 & Bearing. Object sign attached \$ 89051'10" E 62.17 feet. Dist. to Alum. Tag. A steel fence post w/ Bearing Object, Witness sign attached South 1 foot. A steel Guard post w/Bearing Object & Witess sign attached referencing 1972 Brass Cap set by Staebler N 89053'41" W 12.48 feet. Dist to Brass Cap.
