1998: Found 2-3/8" brass cap 4" deep and accessories per LCR 09-040-A (W. Wells, LCR 98-101-C).

Monument(s) & Accessories Found (Condition & Source):

Found monument per LCR 09-040-A lying on road shoulder near corner, apparently destroyed by underground fiber optic installation. Found 2-3/8" aluminum cap W.C. to West and bearing tags on power poles to East & South as noted in LCR 09-040-A above. Found stone 1 foot below surface, N51°27'E 0.80' from the corner. We note that C.S. L-059-B is not clear whether the 1/2" rebar was set in place of the found stone with the stone then placed alongside, or if the stone was left in place and the rebar placed alongside; we have re-monument the corner at the position indicated by the reference monuments.

Monument Set (Procedures & Description):

Re-established 1995 brass cap position from W.C. monument and bearing objects noted above; set 1-1/2" iron pipe with 2-1/2" brass cap 6" below road surface.
