Dependent Resurvey by Frank A. Tuers, under Special Instructions dated April 11, 1975, under Group No. 864. Notes state: The cor. of secs. 17, 18, 19 and 20, monumented with a concrete post, 6 x 6 ins. firmly set, 6 ins. below ground, with nail in center.
