After brass cap monument destroyed, reset a 2-3/8" brass cap on 1-1/4" iron pipe 10" deep from N.E. & S.E. R.P.'s; witness post sign & bearing tag signs set on metal fence posts near the N.W., S.W., and S.E. R.P.'s (Roberts, LCR 96-084-R)
