Established position at record angle & proportioned distances shown on C.S. 82-035-A between brass cap monuments found at NW & SW corners of Section 35; set 2-1/2" brass cap on a 1-1/4" pipe 1.0' deep.


A 5/8 rebar w/ yellow cap stamped "PBS WA-19619 OR-02820" which bears N63°33'06"W 39.34' from the corner; set T-post w/ bearing tag alongside.

A 5/8 rebar w/ yellow cap stamped "PBS WA-19619 OR-02820" which bears N38°22'00"E 51.67' from the corner; set T-post w/ bearing tag alongside.

A 5/8 rebar w/ yellow cap stamped "PBS WA-19619 OR-02820" which bears S50°41'28"E 45.28' from the corner; set bearing tag on power pole 1.0' to SE

A 5/8 rebar w/ yellow cap stamped "PBS WA-19619 OR-02820" which bears S51°37'49"W 51,47' from the corner; set T-post w/ bearing tag alongside.

Monument Detail:



Location & Comments:

Corner falls in the intersection of Joy Lane and Sagebrush Road. A 3" brass cap monument, 1' below surface and 1' North of a fence, marking the initial point of Trott's Acres (Plat Bk. 8 Pg. 5), was found N59°32'56"W 38.66' from the corner; this dimension fits very closely with those shown on the Trott's plat. A 5/8" rebar, marking the SW corner of Lot 1 Blk. 2 of Landover Hills, was found N47°13'48"E 43.09' from the corner; this distance computed per the Landover plat should be 44.36'. Dimensions shown on C.S. H-256-C and Landover Hills (both by Thompson) as well as monuments found within the Landover Hills subdivision indicate Thompson's position for this corner would fall approximately S40°W 1.3' of our position. It is our opinion (shared with the County Surveyor) that Thompson's position should be held for the Landover plat and road centerline to the East, but not the 1/4 corner.
