

Location and Comments

From the intersection of Craig and Progress Roads northeast of Hermiston, travel east 1/2 mile on a dirt road. The corner is a 2" aluminum cap on 5/8" X 30" rebar set approximately 1 foot below ground surface.



Previous Renewals/Surveys, etc. Timothy Davenport, contract No. 101, dated August 5, 1861, set post, built mound, and drove charred stake. John Kimbrell, County Surveyor, set pipe in survey #308, Record of Permanent Surveys, Book 2, dated February 15, 1910. Thomas Lagier (Telek Engineering) set 5/8" rebar in place of a found fence post with railroad spike in top, County Survey #Q-923-C, 1979. Other surveys have ignored Lagier's monument and used a single proportion location.

Monuments & Accessories Found: (Condition and Source) No original evidence was found, nor was Kimbrell's pipe. The corner falls in a cultivated area. Found a 5/8" rebar 1 foot below groundthat is 4.31 feet too far south and 33.85 feet too far west by proportion. The rebar doesn't match Lagier's record position and could have possibly been the same monument moved by property owners.

= Set 5/8" x30" iron rebar with yellow plastic cap marked "UCPWD... LS 2627"

Monument Set (Procedures and Description) Set 2" aluminum cap on 5/8" X 30" iron rebar approximately 1 foot below ground by single proportion between the brass cap found at the Northwest Corner of Section 29 and Kimbrell's pipe found at the Northeast Corner of the section.. Lagier's position was not used.
