MONUMENT SET: Reestablished corner point on line between the calculated Southeast and monumented Southwest corners of Section 18, with the intersection of an old field berm extending North-South through corner point. Set a 2 3/8" diameter brass cap on a 1 1/4" x 30" galvanized iron pipe, with top of brass cap 16" below ground surface in farmed field, stamped as shown in "Monument Marking Detail".

New accessories:

A silver "deep-1" magnet buried 18" in the ground bears N 49° E, 32.0 feet. A blue "deep-1" magnet buried 18" in the ground bears S 27° E, 40.3 feet. A pink "deep-1" magnet buried 18" in the ground bears S 56° W, 32.1 feet. An orange "deep-1" magnet buried 18" in the ground bears N 37° W, 39.9 feet. Buried bearing object sign with each of the "deep-1" magnet accessories.
