### PREVIOUS RENEWALS/SURVEYS ETC.:

Originally established by Odell & Lewis, under GLO Contract No. 110, dated February 7, 1865. Notes state: Set 1/4 Sec. post; drove charred stake; dug pits & raised mound, as per instructions.

Record of Survey No. Q-805-A states: "found rock". BPA Milton Tap Line Transmission line maps show a "rock". Survey No. 98-82-R shows a 8" x 8" by 24" basalt stone.

# MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES FOUND:

Found 28" x 12" x 8" stone set firmly in the ground with the top 8" exposed. Excavated stone and found no visible marks.

## MONUMENT SET:

At position of found stone set a 2 1/2" brass cap on a 1 1/4" by 30" galvanized iron pipe 26" in the ground, marked as shown in Monument Marking Detail. Buried corner stone Northwest of new monument with 8 inches exposed.

#### New accessories:

A 3/4" brass washer stamped "PLS 1106", nailed 1.0 foot above ground level on a monitoring station pole bears South 50° East, 70.9 feet.

A 5/8" x 24" rebar with a 1 1/4" yellow plastic cap marked "OR PLS 1106, WA PLS 17372", flush with the ground bears South 05° East, 67.6 feet.

A 5/8" x 24" rebar with a 1 1/4" yellow plastic cap marked "OR PLS 1106, WA PLS 17372", flush with the ground bears South 49° West, 69.4 feet.

A 5/8" x 24" rebar with a 1 1/4" yellow plastic cap marked "OR PLS 1106, WA PLS 17372", flush with the ground bears North 44° West, 36.7 feet.

Attached bearing object signs to rebar accessories and to monitoring pole. Set steel fence post with "witness" sign 1.0 foot North of brass cap monument.

LOCATION AND COMMENTS: Corner is located on ridge top, 2 1/2 feet Southerly of a field line fence meandering around a farmed area.
