MONUMENT SET:

Held a fence corner with fences East, South and North 27° West as best remaining evidence of the original corner. At a point 0.6' South of fence corner post, set a 2 1/2" brass cap on a 1 1/4" x 30" galvanized iron pipe with cap 2" above ground level. Cap marked as shown in Monument Marking Detail.
