MONUMENT SET:

Corner position was re-established by single proportion measurement between the Southeast and Southwest corners of Section 8, using the Odell and Lewis record. At re-established corner position, set a 2 1/2" brass cap on 1 1/4" x 30" iron pipe with cap 18" below ground level in active farmed field. Marked as shown on Monument Marking Detail.
